

## Requirements for completion

### Department of Histology and Embryology

**Subject: Histology and Embryology 2 (HE2)**

**Year of study, Term: 1st, summer semester**

**Study programme: Dental Medicine**

**Credits: 5**

**Prerequisite for completion of subject Histology and Embryology 2 is a successful completion of Histology and Embryology 1.**

#### **1. For successful completion of the practical exercises is required:**

- a) Student has to attend all practical exercises (100%).
- b) In the case of excused **absence on practical lessons (maximally 3)**, student has to **study missing slides and draw them to the practical textbook individually (self-study) and is obliged to respect and follow the instructions of his/her teacher.**
- c) Student has to pass at least **5 control tests** during the semester and gain the average of results minimally **60 %**.
- d) **In the event of failure to attain these limits**, final exam is not permitted and the **student is graded Fx (failed)** at the end of semester (Study Rules of Procedure P.J.Šafárik University, the Faculty of Medicine, part II., article 13: 1c and 6.)
- e) **Student has to pass Final slide test** performed in the **14th week** of semester, which consists of description of 3 histological slides from the winter and summer semester. For successful completion student has to gain **minimally 60%** for registration to the final exam.

If these conditions are not completed the student has one retake term during the first or second week of the examination period.

#### **2. For successful acquirement of the 5 credits from subject Histology and Embryology 2 is necessary to pass:**

##### **A. Histology and Embryology 1 (4 credits):**

- a) HE1 is completed in the **1 st semester**;
- b) or HE1 is completed in the **2 nd semester during teaching period before Final exam of HE2.**

##### **B. Final exam** consists of 2 parts:

###### **I. Final written test**

The student must gain minimally 60% from the test, to continue to the final oral exam.

###### **II. Final oral exam** - three questions:

- a) cytology and tissues
- b) microscopic anatomy
- c) embryology

Student must pass each of three questions minimally for 60% (E). The **total evaluation of the final exam** includes outcomes of the final slide test and written test and final oral exam (graded A-E).

#### **3. Student who attend all practical exercises (100%), but did not complete conditions of subject Histology and Embryology 1:**

- a) does not obtain credits
- b) will attend the classes of subject Histology and Embryology 2 in summer semester
- c) **the latest in the 14th week of teaching period, the student firstly have to pass conditions of HE1: slide test – minimally for 60% and final semestral test minimally for 60% in the range of subject Histology and Embryology 1.**

**\*Only one retake** will be possible for slide test and final semestral test in summer semester!

After **sucessfull completion** of those conditions student **gain 4 credits from subject HE1.**
