

**RULES
FOR MAKING USE OF COMPUTER TECHNOLOGY, THE INTERNET, AND
ELECTRONIC INFORMATION SOURCES OF THE UL**

Article 1

1. Access to publicly available computers will only be enabled to those registered users, who present their respective User ID Card and register in the Book of Visitors prior to commencing their work.
2. The users shall be obliged to observe the rules contained in the UL Library Regulations and make use of the information sources in accordance with the valid legal and moral standards.

Article 2

1. The users shall be obliged to observe legal protection of copyright law under Copyright Law Act No. 618/2003 Coll. as amended and Law Act No. 428/2002 Coll. on the Protection of Personal Particulars as amended.
2. The information obtained serve exclusively the personal and study purposes of the user, their commercial use, copying, lending, or distribution are forbidden.
3. Browsing through the www sites advertising national, race and any other type of intolerance, pornography and violence is forbidden.

Article 3

1. The users making use of the UL online-register services or information sources complying with specialisation of individual UL workplaces shall enjoy right of preference in making use of the computers.
2. The users are entitled to book a computer in advance. Booking is possible by telephone or personally or by e-mail 1 day in advance.
3. The time period for the work with a computer is limited to 30 minutes, in case of booking, the time period is 60 minutes.
4. The UL hereby reserves the right to impose limitations on the use of computers, should the circumstances require that this be done.

Article 4

1. The users are strongly advised to refrain from changing computer configurations, install any programmes or connect any supplementary equipment. Failing to follow the instructions issued by the UL employees, the latter shall be entitled to call upon the user to immediately put their work at the computer to an end.
2. In case any malfunction occurs in the device, the user shall be obliged to report the same to the UL employee in charge.
3. The users are forbidden to operate their mobile telephones and disturb in any other way the remaining UL users.
4. Repeated violation of the above rules shall lead to the user's being deprived of their right to make use of the UL services.
