This additional financial support for special needs is a contribution based on real costs. Participants with celiac disease or diabetes can also apply for this special needs support. The sending institution has to inform the International Relations Office of the Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice about the selection of a participant with special needs without further delay after the selection of such participant. Such participant has to be a holder of a document proving that he/she is a participant with special needs (for example a severe health disability card or other equivalent document depending on the national legislation).
