Aims			
<p>To get students to be acquainted with human geographical phenomena that students have not managed to observe yet (specific features of population, settlements, economic activities, historical sights).</p>			
Contents			
<p>Students will observe the human geographical phenomena and their spatial distribution over the territory of Slovakia. The aim is to get acquainted with the variability of places:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - different types of landscape in Slovakia – lowland, basin and mountainous relief - historically significant and culturally rich towns, different cultural regions of Slovakia - places with different population structures, settlement structures - differences in economic activities - specific features in transport system
