Aims			
By the end of the course the student will acquire the complex knowledge of each human geographical sphere of the Slovak Republic.			
Contents			
Development of territory and borders of Slovakia. Conditions for settlement in historical context. Population . natural and migration processes, structures – national, linguistic and religious. Settlements – urban and rural settlements. Administrative division of SR – from history to the present. Economy – development and current situation of agriculture, industry, spatial and sectoral structure, transport, active and passive tourism, regionalisation of tourism, foreign trade – commodity and spatial structure.			
Assessment Methods and Criteria			
The Assessment consists of continuous assessment, final test and oral exam. Final test consists of two parts – 1. History, demography and settlements. 2. Economy. The minimum limit is 50 % (grade E) from each. After passing the final test the students continues with oral exam only from one of the parts.			
Grading Scale (in %): A – excellent (excellent results) (numerical value 1: 100% - 90%, B – very good (above average results) – 89% - 80%, 1.5, C – good (average results) 79% - 70% (2) d) D – satisfactory (acceptable results) – 69% - 60%, (2.5) e) E – sufficient (results meet the minimum criteria), 59% - 50% (3) f) FX –failed (requires further work) (4), less than 50 %
