Aims

International excursion provides opportunities to deepen obtained geographic education and to confrontate the theoretic knowledge with real experience in various countries and various kinds of landscape.

The excursion leads to various countries and regions that are accessible by bus within 10-days long trip. It aspire to introduce countries differing in historical and political aspects, physical-geographical attributes as well as social, cultural, demographic and economic aspects.

By the end of the course student student's understanding of various spatial phenomena and processes in the context of geographic relations is enhanced by experience obtained.

Contents

The students will get acquainted with

- geo-political and historical attributes and differences
- introduction of various natural landscapes
- familiarization with different cultures
- experience with population groups differing in language, religion and other aspects and introduction of its relations with social, cultural and political issues in given regions
- information on economic issues and relation

Assessment Methods and Criteria

The assessment is based on:

- participation in the excursion,
- submitting the final report.
