Medical University of Łódź • Poland

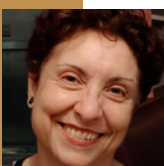

Charles University • Czechia

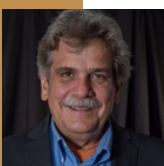
