### RULES FOR USAGE OF COMPUTER TECHNOLOGY, INTERNET, E-RESOURCES AND WIRELESS (WIFI) IN THE UNIVERSITY LIBRARY OF THE PAVOL JOZEF ŠAFÁRIK UNIVERSITY IN KOŠICE

### Article 1

- 1. Access to publicly available computers and usage of wireless connection (hereinafter the "WIFI") will only be enabled to those registered users, who present their user ID card (hereinafter the "PIK" or the "user card").
- 2. The users shall be obliged to observe the rules contained in the Library Regulations of the Uiversity Library of UPJŠ in Košice and use the information sources in accordance with the valid legal standards.

# Article 2

- 1. The user shall be obliged to observe legal protection of copyright law under Copyright Law Act No. 185/2015 Coll. as amended and Law Act No. 18/2018 Coll. on Personal Data Protection as amended regulations.
- 2. The information obtained serve exclusively for the personal and study purposes of the user, their commercial use, copying, lending, or distribution are forbidden.
- 3. Browsing through the websites advertising national, race and any other type of intolerance, pornography and violence is forbidden.

### Article 3

- 1. The users using online catalogue of the University Library of UPJŠ in Košice (hereinafter the "UL") or information sources complying with specialisation of individual UL workplaces shall enjoy right of preference in making use of the computers.
- 2. The users are entitled to reserve a computer in advance. Reservation is possible by telephone, personally or by e-mail 1 day in advance.
- 3. The time period for the work with a computer is limited to 30 minutes, in case of reservation the time period is 60 minutes.
- 4. The UL hereby reserves the right to regulate access to computers.

# Article 4

1. The user can't change computer configuration and install any programms. Connecting additional equipment is allowed only with the agreement of the UL staff. Failing to follow the instructions issued by the UL staff, this has the right to call the user to immediately end their work at the computer.

- 2. In the case of failure on device, the user shall it notify to UL staff.
- 3. In the case of repeated violation rules will user deprive of their right to use UL services.

# Article 5

- 1. There is no legal claim on the WIFI service and UL is not responsible for its accidental drop-out, low signal or damages that can be caused by these circumstances to the users.
- 2. The UL is not responsible for obligations which intervene from the users WIFI use to the third parties.

# Article 6

- 1. The UL does not provide any equipments for use of this service or any technical support for users with their own equipment.
