#### check out web advertisements

you can find current internship offers on various job portals such as [profesia.sk](#), [kariera.sk](#), or [praxuj.sk](#)



#### contact a specific company

if you do not find an offer on the portals that would interest you, don't be afraid to contact a particular company, or staff member (eg on LinkedIn) and find out if they are currently looking for someone. If they are not currently looking for trainees, they will add your CV in a database and will maybe contact you in the future.



#### tell your family, friends

if you're looking for an internship, tell your family, friends, classmates or close ones. Maybe they know about an offer or they know people you can turn to.



#### go on Erasmus+

if you are a bachelor, master or PhD student through an Erasmus + programme, you can have a traineeship abroad (eg in companies and other organizations).

These opportunities are also available to recent graduates.

An internship is a form of professional practice, work or volunteering experience. The average duration of an internship ranges from a few weeks to several months.





# HOW WAS INTERNSHIP BENEFICIAL TO STUDENTS OF UPJŠ?



## **BARBORA** STUDENT OF FACULTY OF ARTS

Since I've loved hockey my entire life, my dream was to work as a sports journalist once, and that's why I see my work at HC Košice as a chance that literally fell from heaven and I am glad I've started building my dream career right there. Since I've worked in an university television at school, I've been able to create creative videos and reports, and we've got a 'free hand' in this at HC. I've learned a lot from PR manager - whether it was organizing promotions, taking pictures or writing articles. I've been given an opportunity to develop not only in PR, but also as a cameraman, and in directing during matches. Working with the A team has expanded over time to include work with young, which has given me further contacts, so I can now communicate with coaches, players and journalists without any problems. Thanks to my work at HC Košice I got into the team of Radio Košice and TV Košice, where I work as a news editor. During the internship I've found out that everything is possible when you want and when you believe. Then you can overcome yourself and work through the whole night. To all of them who study something they really want to do in the future, I recommend going on a internship. Beginnings are difficult, but the best feeling comes when you can do what you dream about for a long time.



## **LUKÁŠ** GRADUATE OF FACULTY OF LAW

I've had a practical experience in my field before my internship, but I wanted to broaden my horizons with experience in other areas. I did not want my view of law to be conveyed only through lectures and through my work in a law firm. During my internship at the Department of Analytics at the Office of the Constitutional Court of the Slovak Republic, I've been working mainly on the case law of the European Court of Human Rights, but also on the Constitutional Court of the Slovak Republic or the EU Court of Justice. The result was an analytical overview of the case law on the given topic. The results of the analysis were then consulted and discussed with my supervisor and were included in the relevant database. Internship had increased my confidence because I've been able to make legal analyzes based on working with a foreign language. Because of this I am no longer afraid of English and I do master it at a high level. In addition to providing irreplaceable practical experience, the internship will also give a more comprehensive theoretical perspective on the chosen field of study. At the same time, it distinguishes a person in his CV from other students who just want to swim through the study.



## JANA

### STUDENT OF FACULTY OF MEDICINE


In July 2017, I had completed a research internship in Brazil, which left a big mark on me, so I decided to go to a clinical internship on the other side of the world (Bandung, Indonesia) and try something new. When I was applying for an internship I had to choose from a large number of departments. My clear choice was surgery (General Surgery). On the first day I had to choose 2 surgical fields, two weeks for each. After careful consideration, abdominal and plastic surgery came to me as the best decision. I had the opportunity to attend meetings of all primary and medical doctors and watch how they consulted and deal with their cases (Case Studies). I spent the rest of the day at the operating theaters where everything was explained and shown to me as far as possible. I spent weekends and all evenings with other trainees. I would definitely recommend internship to everyone! There is no need to be afraid, you just need to go. Every single internship, whether research or clinical, is unique and specific. You acquire new knowledge that nobody will ever take away from you, but you also get to know wonderful, passionate and purposeful people as you are from all over the world. Therefore, do not forget to behave with respect and appreciate the hospitality of local people. Do not hesitate and sign up! If you never try, you will never know.



## KATARÍNA

### STUDENT OF FACULTY OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

I've wanted to take full advantage of the summer and gain experience that I will use either at school or in my future work and meet new interesting people. It was a summer internship at the Legal Department of the Public Defender of Rights (GTC) in Bratislava for 2 months. For the first time they had an intern who did not live or study in Bratislava. As part of the agenda, I dealt with complaints mainly of individuals, or offered them legal assistance to which other authorities can turn, if this is not within the scope of the GTC. Thanks to internship I've found out what the agenda of one of the constitutional officials of the Slovak Republic looks like, I've learned to write various forms of submissions and what various complaints are troubling citizens when they come into contact with public authorities. I got to know great people, learned a lot from them, and in addition, I have a friendly relationship with them for several years after the internship. It has also broadened my horizons about functioning in the state administration. There is no need to worry, even if an internship is in another city or even a country in which you live or study, it will teach you much more and give you greater advantages over other peers.



## MATÚŠ

### STUDENT OF FACULTY OF SCIENCE

I have decided to go on an internship because I wanted to learn something new, from other people that I meet at the university and at the same time to see the world. It's been a three-week internship at a joint nuclear research institute in Dubna, Russia. I worked in an information technology laboratory to learn the basics of parallel and distributed programming. The output of the internship was a brief presentation of what we've learned. Professionally, I got the basics of openMP and MPI, and I've tried some FORTRAN programming language. But much more valuable transformation was that I've seen how science works at one of the top workplaces in Russia, what is the mentality, environment ... I've learned a little Russian to read Cyrillic. The best part was that I could have gone on a trip to Moscow twice and when the events were for all the students from the internship. I had no downright bad experience, but it's been always annoying to enter and exit the workplace to pass through the control of soldiers with auto-rifles who guarded the complex. I've confirmed to myself, that in the future I want to focus on western countries, not that it was bad there, but if I leave home, it has to be somewhere where life is much better than here, which there is not.



## KRISTÍNA

### STUDENT OF FACULTY OF MEDICINE

Since I love traveling, meeting new cultures and new people, I've decided to apply for an internship and it was a success. In the summer, I took part in a one-month research internship in Casablanca, Morocco. I've spent a month at the Institute of Epidemiology, where I've been guided by a professor and two other tutors. They've explained everything to me, and thanks to them I've learned the basics of bio-statistics, how to create questionnaires, which we've been bringing to doctors in individual departments and I've learned to work with the SPSS program. Although I've been in a research internship, I've been also in the hospital, I've attended a sewing course in traumatology. After school and on weekends, we went on excursions with other interns and Moroccan students. I have a lot of beautiful memories from this internship, I've met many people from all over the world and even though they were from different cultures and with different religions, we became good friends. I've learned how they study medicine in Morocco, but also in other countries, and of course I improved my English. I would recommend anyone to take an internship, because this is a great opportunity.

# ERASMUS+ TRAINEESHIP

DID YOU KNOW THAT YOU DON'T JUST HAVE TO GO TO ERASMUS ON ANOTHER UNIVERSITY? YOU CAN CHOOSE AN EMPLOYER IN THE EUROPEAN UNION (PREFERABLY IN YOUR FIELD), REACH OUT TO THEM, NEGOTIATE CONDITIONS WITH THEM AND YOUR FACULTY, AND RECEIVE EU FUNDING. AND THAT IS A GOOD DEAL RIGHT?

The Erasmus + program allows to stimulate and intensively support the education and training of university students and recent graduates in the form of foreign mobility and traineeship. It offers students the following types of mobility activities:

- **Student mobility for study (SMS)** - duration of 3 months (or one semester or trimester) to 12 months for each degree of study,
- **Student mobility for traineeship, including recent graduates (SMP)** - duration of 2-12 months for each degree of study,
- **Combined mobility** - the student can combine a practical traineeship with a study visit as one mobility abroad. One mobility means:
  - traineeship must be organized by the same university where the student will study;
  - these two activities must follow or be simultaneous;
  - grant amount is determined as for the grant amount for the study.

During one degree of study, **each student can go to multiple mobilities for a total of 12 months** (SMS+SMP). The exception applies only to single-cycle study programs, such as: medicine, where a cumulative length of 24 months is allowed. In case of multiple mobility, the minimum duration of each mobility must be maintained (SMS 3 months, SMP 2 months). A total of 12 (or 24) months also includes mobility completed during the study of the same degree at another university.

In the case of a fresh graduate traineeship, the 12-month limit shall include the mobility at the last stage of the study during which the student applied for a traineeship. E.g. if the student was at the Master's degree on 6-month mobility for the purpose of study, as a graduate can only go on an internship for max. 6 months. The traineeship (both student and graduate) should be „full-time“. **A digital skills traineeship has become a priority.**

Student must be selected for the traineeship during the last year of his / her study and the traineeship must begin and end no later than one year after the completion of the study. Before leaving, a graduate may go to the labor office if he does not want to be a self-payer of contributions to the health and social insurance and register as a job seeker.

Financial support is not intended to cover all the costs of a traineeship abroad, but to cover part of the increased mobility costs. It is necessary to count on financial participation, or try to agree with the employer. The lump sum per month includes both the student's subsistence and travel costs.

What do I get from such a traineeship? The aim of the Erasmus + mobility (traineeship) is to offer an opportunity to apply theoretical knowledge and practical skills acquired in the student's field of study in a specific work environment abroad and to extend this knowledge to new professional knowledge and skills. In students who have completed Erasmus + Mobility Abroad, employers see the strengthening of key competences such as effective and foreign language communication, intercultural competence, teamwork, organizational skills, problem solving, information literacy, creativity, and so on. The qualification profile of students and recent graduates is also significantly strengthened and contributes to professional and personal growth, thus increasing **attractiveness of the graduate in terms of employability**.

## THE PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING:

### 1. Contact an Erasmus + coordinator |

Announce interest in mobility.

### 2. Find out the terms and dates of the selection procedures |

Criteria and deadlines are set by faculties / departments / institutes.

### 3. Address the host organization |

The host organization will be addressed by a student or faculty / department / institute. The host organization must be able to provide min. 2-month mobility - traineeship in the student's field of study.

### 4. Verify the host organization |

Verify that the host organization (or traineeship program provided by the host organization to the student) is appropriate for the particular field of study.

### 5. Find out the conditions of the internship abroad |

Taking into account study at UPJŠ in Košice (recognition of the traineeship abroad, study plan at UPJŠ during mobility, individual study plan).

### 6. Wait for the results |

After the publication of the results of the selection procedure, follow the further Erasmus+ coordinator instructions.

# ERASMUS+ TRAINEESHIP EXPERIENCE IN POLAND

## **Why have you decided to go on a traineeship?**

As a full-time PhD student at the Faculty of Public Administration, we have to stay abroad as one of the conditions for completing our studies. Of course, I've chosen the country in which I wanted to take a traineeship.

## **Briefly describe the traineeship you have completed.**

I've completed the traineeship at the Alcide De Gasperi University of Euroregional Economy in Józefowo near Warsaw. As a PhD student, I've had an individual program at the host institution. The Polish colleagues greeted me very warmly, and during the traineeship they took care of me intensively both in and outside the school in their free time.

## **Which new skills / knowledge / experience did you gain through the traineeship?**

Traineeship mainly gave me new contacts to experts and researchers, I can say that not only from Poland but from the world. The host institution, on which I have completed a traineeship, cooperates with universities and colleges from around the world and also has several external teachers, not only from the university environment but also from practice. Of course I had the opportunity to get to know another country. Although Poland is, as you can say, "here around the corner", its capital city has a wonderful atmosphere and is attractive for tourists. In my free time, I had the opportunity to visit several cultural monuments, museums and galleries and learn a lot of interesting facts from the history of this country, which is really varied and interesting.

## **How did the traineeship help you?**

Traineeship helped me mainly in professional and scientific way. Since I am in the third year of my PhD studies and fully devoted to writing my dissertation, I've been very pleased by meetings with teachers and researchers at the host institution, with whom I could consult various questions about my work. I've gained new knowledge and mainly suggestions and advice for my dissertation, which I rate very positively. I certainly appreciate the possibility of using foreign literature, which is very important for my thesis and I've been going to the university library quite intensively during the whole traineeship. Traineeship also helped me to improve my communication in a foreign language and not to worry about not always saying everything grammatically correct.

## **What have you found out about yourself thanks to the traineeship?**

I've certainly found out that communication in a foreign language, in my case in two of them, because there were situations when I had to speak Polish, could not be as difficult as I thought.

## **Would you recommend other students to participate in a traineeship?**

Certainly yes. Erasmus + offers students not only traineeship but also a study stay and I've had an opportunity to use both options. It is a unique opportunity to travel with financial support, which will give you many new experiences and new friendships.
