Requirements for completion

I. For successful completion of practical exercises is required:

- Attendance of lectures during semester and participate in seminars.
- Theoretical and practical performance of exercises and to get at least 60 % (in average) of total score from preliminary tests.
- The achievement at least 60 % from the credit test.

II. For successful completion of Clinical Biochemistry is necessary:

- Granting credit for practical exercises (60 % of tests; see point I.).
- Successfully managing a written examination.
- The written test consists of a test consisting of 25 questions within the topics of the curriculum:
 - the tests are written during 45 min.
 - the tests are evaluated by teachers of the department
 - each student receives for his/her answer from 0 (incorrect or no answer) to 4 points (fully correct answer) per question
 - maximal number of points (= percentage) is 100 (%) for whole test
 - the final mark for the written test is determined by the scale as follows:
