Requirements for completion

Subject: **Pathological Physiology I**Year of study, Term: 3rd year, WT
Study programme: **General Medicine**

1. For successful completion of the practical exercises/seminars is required:

- Participation at all of practical lessons (seminars) is obligatory.
- Any absence has to be explained and compensated.
- Forms of compensation:
 - Visiting a lesson of another group (of the same study programme) within the same week. This presumes consent of both, the class teacher and the teacher of the group that student is visiting.
 - Compensatory work (printed report) and/or audio-visual presentation on the topics missed by student. Details are to be consulted with teacher.
 - Compensation via additional exercises in the afternoon can be done after agreement from group's teacher and the head of the department.
- There is no possibility for compensation of the exercises during the examination period.
- Maximum of excused absences should not exceed 3 during one semester.
- Presentations of selected topics related to practical lesson topic (1-2 PowerPoint presentations during semester.
- Oral examination from the topics covering the lectures and seminars.
- Written examinations from lectures and seminar topics (quiz). Quizzes are passed if the student got the rating A-E, i.e. succeeded min. in 60 % of total points.
- Practical lessons are organized as seminars and tutorials. Activity in discussion and problem solving tasks is required.

2. For successful obtained of the credits from subject is necessary:

- Fulfilled conditions for completion of practical exercises (paragraph 1 above).
- Minimally 50% attendance of lectures.
- To get at least 60% from each one part (multiple choice part and open questions part) of 2 credit tests
- In the case of a missed revision test or failure (less than 60 % from the revision tests), student has 2 possibilities to write it again during 2 correction terms. Correction terms are common for all students. Terms for correction, are announced in department web site.
- Evaluation: Study rules of procedure UPJŠ in Košice, the Faculty of Medicine, Part II, Art 13.
- The final classification includes the evaluation of the credit tests and the results obtained in practical exercises.
