Requirements for completion

Subject: CLINICAL BIOCHEMISTRY

Year of education: 5., WS

Study program: General Medicine

I. For successful completion of practical exercises is required:

- Compulsory attendance on at least 75 % of all of lectures held during semester and participate in all seminars.
- Theoretical and practical performance of all seminars and to get at least 60 % in average of total score from all preliminary tests (written before each seminar).
- In the case of failure (less than 60 % from the preliminary tests), student will prepare an extra project according instruction of the teacher.

II. For successful completion of Clinical Biochemistry is necessary:

- Granting credit for seminars (60 % of tests; see point I.).
- The written exam test consists of 25 questions within the topics of the curriculum:
 - the tests are written for 45 min,
 - the tests are evaluated by teachers of the department,
 - each student receives for his/her answer from 0 (incorrect or no answer) to 4 points (fully correct answer) per question,
 - maximal number of points is 100 (100 %) for whole test,
 - the final mark of the written test is determined by the scale as follows:
