

Dear students,

the final exam in the subject of Pathological Anatomy in AY 2022/2023 will be carried out during the examination period (22.5. - 30.6.) in a presence form.

**You will be able to register for the exam dates in AIS from 6.5.2022, 10:00.**

**You can take the final exam only after fulfilling the conditions for the credit and proceeding to the final exam.**

Exam dates are scheduled each working day during the entire exam period with a sufficient number of places for registration, which also includes places for repeated registration in case of unsuccessful completion of the regular term (repeated registrations are already included). **In case of interest, dates will also be scheduled in the 14th week of the semester.**

**We will not increase the number of students at the end of the examination period, if the earlier dates are still free, it is necessary to register for the already scheduled free date.** Therefore, it is necessary to plan and distribute all your exams evenly so that you can apply for a suitable and your desired date for the Pathological Anatomy exam.

You can register for the exam **no later than 2 days in advance**, and cancel the registration if the date does not suit you **at least 2 days in advance**. Please adhere to these deadlines, you register or deregister in AIS by yourselves at the permitted interval, **the staff of the Institute of Pathology will not do it for you. After the specified interval, changes in AIS will no longer be possible.**

**If you do not appear for the exam on the day you are registered and do not deliver (do not send) an apology (from the doctor, serious family reasons ...) within 3 days from the date of the exam, you will be awarded the FX mark.**

At the beginning of the exam **you will choose one of the theoretical exam triplet questions, you will have 30 minutes for written preparation. To successfully pass the exam, it is necessary to answer all the questions from the triplet that fall under your chosen exam question.**

Upon successful completion of the exam, you will be notified of the mark, which the examiner will enter in the AIS. After failing the exam, you register for a corrective exam. In addition to the regular date, you have 2 corrective dates, in case of repeated registration of subject 1 corrective date.
