

Call for applications for Erasmus+ Short-term blended STUDY mobility for students (MUDr/MDDr/Bc/Mgr)

2023/2024

Department for International Relations at the Faculty of Medicine, UPJŠ would like to inform you about the possibility of applying for Erasmus **Short-term blended STUDY mobility for students (MUDr/MDDr/Bc/Mgr)** in the academic year 2023/2024.

Implementation period: until **31.7.2024**

For whom: The short-term blended student mobilities are intended for doctoral (MUDr/MDDr), bachelor's (Bc) and master's (Mgr) students.

Is this type of mobility available for recent graduates?: No

Place of mobility: Traineeship is possible to take at partner universities [here](#)

It is possible to travel to any university with which your study field has an inter-institutional agreement.

Duration of mobility: 5 to 30 days of physical mobility + mandatory virtual element

Funding: grant up to the amount covering **5 days** of physical mobility abroad.

Compulsory documents:

Optional documents (provide proof of membership by written confirmation):

- photocopy of a certificate of proficiency in a foreign language, photocopy of graduation exam (except native speakers)
- SSW,
- active member of the Association of Medical Students in Kosice,
- extracurricular activities associated with the study

The selection committee will assess: student academic results, foreign language knowledge, extracurricular activities associated with the study, the information contained in the application form.

The results of the selection procedure will be published in AIS **within 10 days** from the end of the given phase of the call.

Obligations: it is necessary to obtain at least 3 ECTS credits during the mobility.

Recognition: The earned credits will be recognized in full for the student upon return. After the mobility, **it is necessary to apply for the recognition of credits** according to the procedure at the Faculty of medicine.

Grants:

Participants of a short-term mobility (5-30 days) are entitled to individual support for physical mobility days, including travel days, regardless of destination country:		
Target country	1st-14th day	15th-30th day
	Rate/day	Rate/day
All programme countries	70	50

Anything extra?

- Mobility participants with fewer opportunities are entitled to a one-time contribution above the basic rate in the amount of **€100** for physical mobility lasting 5-14 days.
- Students can apply for the so-called "green travel" contribution. This is a one-time contribution of **EUR 50** in addition to the regular grant if the student uses: train, bus, shared car, bicycle as a mode of transportation for his/her trip to and/or from mobility.
- Participants with fewer opportunities can be granted support for travel costs. Travel expenses are covered by a special scale of fixed amounts according to distance bands valid for the entire program:

Travel distance	Standard travel	Green travel
From 10 to 99 km:	23 EUR per participant	
From 100 to 499 km	180 EUR per participant	210 EUR per participant
From 500 to 1 999 km:	275 EUR per participant	320 EUR per participant
From 2 000 to 2 999 km:	360 EUR per participant	410 EUR per participant
From 3 000 to 3 999 km:	530 EUR per participant	610 EUR per participant
From 4 000 to 7 999 km:	820 EUR per participant	
8 000 km or more:	1 500 EUR per participant	

- Other participants are not entitled to support for travel costs.
