Exam consists of:

1/ Anatomical pictures, 30 structures = 30 points. Student has to achieve at least 60% to continue to the next part of the exam. Points obtained from this part of the exam, are not added to the final evaluation!

Important information about the picture test !!!

The picture test will do all students except of them who have repeatedly registered subject Anatomy (only two attempts) and the first of them they did in September or in October. If they were successful in the test of Anatomical pictures (but not in the written test) they will fluently continue to the written test. If no, they will do also the test of Anatomical pictures!

2/ Written test, consists of 100 questions (each question has 4 choices, but only one of them is correct).
