The Summer school will be based on teambased learning (TBL) focused on a specific drug category or treatment of a condition. Each TBL lesson is preceded by an individual pre-class reading. The TBL lesson is then initiated by checking on understanding the information, first in an individual and then in a team-based rapid assessment test. This is followed by a virtual patient case report and a discussion of the individual topics. You can look forward to topics such as clinical pharmacology of antithrombotics, pain management, or principles of drug dosing in patients with renal or hepatic insufficiency. And much more.

# **SUMMER SCHOOL of Applied and Clinical Pharmacology**

#### General information:

The Summer School of Applied and Clinical Pharmacology is an activity of the Department of Pharmacology, Faculty of Medicine, Masaryk University, Brno, offered to international medical and pharmacy students who are interested not only in deepening their knowledge in pharmacology, clinical pharmacology and therapeutics, training the prescribing skills and developing the skills of medication optimization, but also in traveling, visiting the Czech Republic, and making new friends across Europe.

#### **Education format, resources:**

The Summer school will be based on flipped classrooms and team-based learning (TBL) focused on a specific drug category or treatment of a condition. An individual pre-class reading precedes each TBL lesson. The TBL lesson is then initiated by checking on understanding the information, first in an individual and then in a team-based readiness assessment test. A virtual patient case report and a discussion of the individual topics follow this. During summer school, we will also play an escape game, practice a medication review and assessment of adverse effects, try to read and design a clinical trial, etc.

The pre-class reading and video-recordings will be shared with the students before the first lesson. All materials are tailored to each individual lesson and are available in electronic and printable form. The access uses unique credentials (UCO generated for each student + password). Time allocation for self-study is 3 hours per TBL lesson.

#### Discussed topics:

- clinical pharmacology of analgesics, antihypertensives and diuretics, antipsychotics, antibiotics, antiemetics; drug-induced ion dysbalances and their therapies;
- reasonable prescribing, WHO-6-step in medical prescribing, medication review;
- practial pharmacovigilance
- principles of planning and designing clinical trials.

#### Requirements for the students:

#### General requirements:

- English at B1 level and above, basic knowledge of professional terminology in English,
- basic knowledge of general pharmacology (knowledge of pharmacodynamics and pharmacokinetics principles),
- basic understanding of special pharmacology (ability to classify drugs into groups, knowledge of the basic profile of drugs from the above groups - indications, contraindications, side effects)

#### Before and during classes:

- to attend all online and face-to-face sessions;
- be prepared have studied pre-class reading, watching videos, prepared medication review of assigned cases;
- · be active.

### Venue:

The programme of Summer school will take place on the University campus, specifically in the <u>Simulation Centre of the Faculty of Medicine</u>, Masaryk University (SIMU). The exact address is Kamenice 3, Brno, 625 00.
