

Structure of final exam in Pathology

Final exam in subject Pathological anatomy 2 takes place during examining period of the summer term

- **is in oral form in person**
- **includes 3 questions (1 triplet from exam questions)**

- structure of oral answer is to be as follows:
 - definition of the problem/diagnose
 - etiology
 - pathogenesis
 - classification
 - clinical signs including complications
 - diagnostics and treatment
 - morphology – macroscopic appearance
 - morphology – microscopic appearance

- for students who passed the practical exam in AR 2021/2022, but failed the theoretical exam, they have recognized practical exercises and credit, so the exam:

- **is in oral form in person**
- **includes 3 questions (1 triplet from exam questions)**

- for students who failed the practical exam in AR 2021/2022 and want to have recognized practical exercises and credit, then the exam:

- **is in oral form in person**
- **consists of a practical exam:**

- takes place in the practice room on the day of the exam - before the oral exam
- students choose 3 preparations (slides) from the spectrum of 140 that they studied during practical lessons
- in order to successfully pass the practical exam, it is necessary to correctly establish at least 2 diagnoses out of 3
- if the student fails the practical exam, he receives an Fx evaluation for the final exam and must repeat both the practical and the oral part of the exam
- if the student passes the practical exam but fails the oral exam, he gets an Fx rating for the final exam and only has to repeat the oral exam

- **and theoretical exam includes 3 questions (1 triplet from exam questions)**
