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Assessment of the student's learning achievements in Biology 2 and Medical and Human Biology 2

Assessment of the student's learning achievements in Biology 2 and Medical and Human Biology 2 is carried out as a combination of continuous monitoring of the study during the teaching period of the summer semester (40%) and the oral examination during the examination period of the summer semester (60%).

Continuous monitoring of the study during the teaching part of the summer semester (40%) will be realized in the form of two written tests in 7th and 13th teaching week. All students will take the test together during the lecture in respective week.

Passing requirements:

- active presence in all practical lessons
- each test assessment minimum of 50%
- oral exam

If a student cannot take part in the test at the given date for serious reasons (especially health problems), he/she must apologize to the Head of the department or the teaching assistant in advance, but no later than 7 days after the settled date of the test. If he/she does not do it and does not submit serious reasons, he/she is given 0 points for this test. Students, who apologize, will be given one alternative term for each apologized test during the last week of the teaching period of the summer semester.

If a student would not obtain 50% from the test in regular term, he/she can retake the corresponding test in the last week of the teaching period of the summer semester. The date of the retake will be announced one week prior to the retake at latest. If a student cannot take part in the retake test at the given date for serious reasons he/she should proceed and apologize as described in previous paragraph. Alternative term for properly apologized students who could not attend the retakes will be announced later, if necessary.

All practical lessons (100%) are obligatory for the students.

It is necessary to have the textbook and own exercise book for practical lessons. Student is required to prepare for practical lessons (read the theory in the textbook), write protocol and/or solve tasks and problems on each studied topic.

If a student cannot take part in the practical lesson, he/she can compensate for the lesson within the same week as the lesson is normally held in another group of international students. Student has to compensate the same topic he/she missed. There must be a serious reason for the compensation. Non-participation in practical exercises must be properly excused with the teacher, who will determine a substitution/compensation in the corresponding form. The student may compensate the excused practical exercises within three weeks at most during the semester (*Study Rules of Procedure P. J. Šafárik University in Košice the Faculty of Medicine*).

Procedure for the final evaluation of the study results

Continuous assessment during the summer semester:

Prerequisite for oral examination (to register for the oral examination):

- the acquirement of **50% minimum** from each test during the summer semester

Oral examination:

A – 60 points

B – 52 points

C – 44 points

D – 36 points

E – 28 points

Final evaluation grade:

continuous assessment +
oral examination)

A – > 90 - 100 points

B – > 83 - 90 points

C – > 74 - 83 points

E – 60 - 67 points
