► CONFIDENTIALITY

The students are obliged to keep confidential all information related to the health condition and autopsy findings of the deceased, any other facts about the deceased and his/her relatives, the circumstances of the death, and information of a confidential nature, which are discussed during teaching or in connection with the teaching at the Department of Forensic Medicine of UPJŠ in Košice, Faculty of Medicine, and Medico-Legal and Pathological-Anatomical Department of HCSA in Košice. Breach of confidentiality obligation violates not only the rules of professional ethics, but also generally binding legal regulations of the Slovak Republic and the EU.

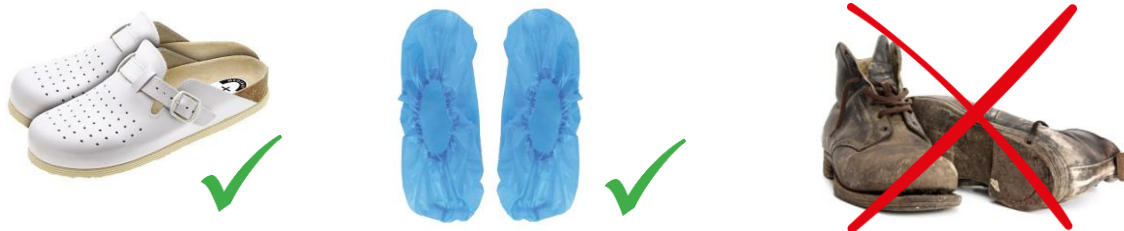
Instructions on confidentiality obligation are provided on the first practical.

Students verify with their signatures that they were instructed on confidentiality obligation.

► TEACHING AT THE DEPARTMENT OF FORENSIC MEDICINE

Students are required to wear slippers for entering the department.

Scrubs/coats are not needed.



It is prohibited to enter the department with drinks in disposable cups, either with or without cover.



► **TEACHING IN THE AUTOPSY ROOM**

AT THE MEDICO-LEGAL AND PATHOLOGICAL-ANATOMICAL DEPARTMENT OF HCSA

Students enter the HCSA building accompanied by the teacher. They enter only after all the students of given groups are present.

The teacher will let the students into the dressing room, where coats and disposable protective material – caps, masks, shoe covers will be available for them to take.

It is **PROHIBITED** to take any personal belongings, including water and food, to the autopsy room.

Entry to the autopsy room is allowed only when accompanied by the teacher!

It is **PROHIBITED** to touch the dead bodies and the equipment (tables, instruments) inside the autopsy room.

Students are obliged to behave respectfully, so they would not disturb the present personnel.

Before entering the dressing room after the autopsy, the students will throw away the used disposable materials in the waste bag prepared by the door to the dressing room.

Coats must be returned to the dressing room and put back in their original place.

Students use only the bathroom located within the dressing room.

Students are obliged to keep the dressing room and bathroom clean.



► **TEACHING IN THE LABORATORIES**
AT THE MEDICO-LEGAL AND PATHOLOGICAL-ANATOMICAL DEPARTMENT OF HCSA

Students enter the HCSA building accompanied by the teacher. They enter only after all the students of given groups are present.

The teacher will let the students into the dressing room, where coats and shoe covers will be available for them to take.

It is PROHIBITED to take any personal belongings, including water and food, to the laboratories.

Entry to the laboratory is allowed only when accompanied by the teacher!

It is PROHIBITED to touch laboratory equipment, samples, or any documentation.

Students are obliged to behave respectfully, so they would not disturb the present personnel.

Before entering the dressing room after the class, the students will throw away the used disposable shoe covers in the waste bag prepared by the door to the dressing room.

Coats must be returned to the dressing room and put back in their original place.

Students use only the bathroom located within the dressing room.

Students are obliged to keep the dressing room and bathroom clean.
