Topics of theory tests **Anatomy 2:**

1. skull, cervical vertebrae, connections of skull and cervical vertebrae, muscles of head and neck, vessels of head and neck
2. innervation of head and neck, cranial nerves – nuclei, exits of brain and skull, cervical spinal nerves, ANS in general, ANS of head and neck
3. topography of head and neck, fascias of head and neck, eye, ear

Topics of practical tests **Anatomy 2:**

1. skull and cervical vertebrae, muscles of head and neck, vessels of head and neck
2. nerves of head and neck
3. skull, muscles, nerves, and vessels of head and neck, eye, ear

Topics of theory tests **Anatomy 1:**

1. introduction to anatomy; bones, joints, muscles, vessels and nerves in general, bones, joints, muscles, vessels and nerves of limbs and trunk important regions of upper and lower limbs; whole digestive system
2. respiratory system, heart, mediastinum, abdominal cavity, urogenital system, pelvis
3. structures and function of CNS

Topics of practical tests **Anatomy 1:**

1. bones, joints, muscles, vessels and nerves of limbs and trunk, oral cavity and pharynx
2. digestive system, respiratory system, heart, mediastinum, abdominal cavity, urogenital system
3. structures of CNS

Student must obtain at least 60 % from each test (e.g. **12** points from each practical test and **24** points from each theoretical test) to pass the tests successfully and get credit. Student's registration for the retaken tests is free of registration in the AIS.
