- 1, 100% attendance at lectures
- 2, **100% active participation in practical exercises** (knowledge verification is done orally or in writing)
- 3, **10x comprehensive examination of the prosthetic patient** with a complete medical documentation, X-ray analysis and a draft treatment plan for fixed restorations
- 4, 5x making study impressions and study models
- **5, 1x making of the fixed restoration** (pillar preparation, impressions, try in of metal framework, delivery of restoration)
- 6, **1x making of RPD** (model analysis, impressions, design preparation, Mx-Mn relationship, try in of the RPD, delivery of RPD)
- 7, **1x making a complete removable restoration** (pre-prosthetic restoration, primary impressions, functional impressions, determination of the Mx-Mn relationship and selection of tooth color, wax-up of teeth, handover of the complete removable restoration, patient instruction, repair/adjustment of the complete removable restoration)
- 8, **1x making of the splint** (relaxation splint with CJR determinantion) examination of TMJ
- 9, **7x pre-prosthetic preparation**: DH, or filling of abutment/clasp tooth, or endodontic treatment of abutment, or tooth extraction

**Objective**: complex prosthetic treatment of the patient in condition of general dental surgery – examination of the patient, identification of the prothetic problem, treatment planning, pre – prosthetic preparation of the patient, prosthetic therapy – fixed + removable restorations, education of the patient, recall
