Requirements for completion

Subject: Pathological anatomy 1
Year: Third year of study, WT

Study programme: General Medicine

- 0. For registration of subject (prerequisite for registration) is successful completion of the subject Anatomy 2 and Histology and Embryology 2 (an assessment in the range of A-E) is necessary.
- I. For successful completion/recognition of the subject (prerequisite for subject completion) and earning the credits for the subject, the following is necessary:

Successful completion of practical lessons/seminars

Successful completion of two written revision tests

Attendance on lectures at least 50%

II. For successful completion of the practical lessons/seminars is required:

- Mandatory 100% participation in practical lessons. Theoretical preparation for the lessons and methodical mastering of practical tasks.
- According to the Study Rules of Procedure at UPJŠ in Košice, Faculty of Medicine, Part II, Art. 12, Paragraph 8, non-participation in practical lessons must be justified.
- In the case of excused absence from practical lesson, the student is required to compensated practical lesson in the form of a seminar work based on the teacher's instructions. During the semester, it is possible to compensate a maximum of three practical lessons.

III. For successful completion of two written revision tests is required:

- To get at least 60% (average) from both written revision tests.
- The date of each of the two written revision tests is scheduled in advance.
- Participation in both revision tests is mandatory. In the case of unexcused absence from the revision tests, a student cannot take part in the alternate date or retake credit test, in case of excused absence from the revision tests, the student will have the opportunity to attend alternate date of revision test in week 14th.
- If the student does not get the required evaluation from the written revision tests, the student will have the opportunity to write two retake credit tests, which are in the scope of the topics from the entire semester (topic of weeks 1-13). And the dates of which will be determined at the end of the winter term and one date of which is set in the 14th week of the semester and the 2nd date will be set at the end of the winter semester in the winter examination period of the academic year. It is up to the student whether he/she uses both set dates.

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- The tests are evaluated based on the number of points (%) achieved according to the Study Rules of Procedure at UPJŠ in Košice, Faculty of Medicine, Part II, Art. 13, Paragraph 4:
 - results 91 100 % are evaluated "completed A- excelent",
 - results 84 90 % are evaluated "completed B very good",
 - results 75 83 % are evaluated "completed C good",
 - results 68 74 % are evaluated "completed D satisfactory",
 - results 60 67 % are evaluated "completed E sufficient".
- I. If any of the conditions in point 0 is not met by the end of the 3rd teaching week, the student does not continue to meet other conditions.
- II. The final exam in pathology takes place in the exam period of the summer term.
