

Requirements for completion

Department of Anatomy

Subject: **Anatomy 1**

Year of study, Term: **First, WT**

Study programme: **General Medicine**

In order to successfully complete the subject Anatomy 1, as a “prerequisite for registration the subsequent subject Anatomy 2” it is necessary to:

- **75 % active presence in lectures** (three absences without giving a reason are allowed).
- **100% active mandatory participation in practical lessons.** If student is not present in practical lesson (maximum 3 times) due to serious healthy or personal reasons, his/her absence must be excused by the teacher and compensation of the missing practical lesson completed at the Department of Anatomy within ongoing practical lessons/seminars of the other groups ((or as self-study in the consultation-preparation room) until the end of the winter semester. The compensation during practical lessons/seminars is not allowed one week before the practical test (so-called repetition week) !
- Theoretical and methodical mastery of practical tasks.

In order to successfully complete the subject Anatomy 1 as a “prerequisite for completion the subject Anatomy 2”, the student:

- **is obliged to pass all** ongoing theoretical (written) and practical tests – i.e. 3 theoretical and 3 practical tests (controls) – the total number of points he/she can achieve **from theoretical tests is 120 and from practical tests 60**
- must achieve at least 60% success rate, i.e. 24 points from each theoretical test and 12 points from each practical test.

If the student does not achieve the minimum number of points from each part of the thematic unit, he/she is entitled to take:

The first retake test:

- theoretical (written) test – in the week following the regular ongoing written test and on the day of the respective practical lesson
- practical test – on the Friday of the week following the regular ongoing practical test

The second retake test:

- during the WS examination period.

The student will take the retake test only from that part of the thematic unit in which he/she did not achieve the minimum number of points (24 from the theoretical test and 12 from the practical test).

If a student successfully passes each theoretical (written) and practical tests in the regular term, i.e., achieves at least 24 points in the theoretical test and 12 points in the practical test individually, he/she will receive 1 point (3+3 points) for each successful test, i.e. 6 points for the semester. The points earned (similarly for the summer semester) will be added to the student's score of the final picture and written tests.

If the student does not take part in the theoretical and practical tests for any reason (personal, family, health), he/she will not have an alternative date, but will take the given exam on the retake test. If the student does not take part in the first or second retake tests for any reason, he/she **is not entitled** to a replacement date.

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Other conditions:

- A student who does not justify his non-participation in writing the tests in accordance with the established rules, does not achieve at least 60% of the theoretical and practical tests (individually) and does not succeed even in the retaken term, will be automatically evaluated with the grade Fx – "failed". Continuous control tests are evaluated based on the number of points achieved (%) with evaluation according to the Study Regulations of the UPJŠ in Košice, Faculty of Medicine, II. part, Art. 13, paragraph 4.

- Final credit rating "passed A to E"

- The final assessment takes into account the results of the continuous assessment

The table summarizing the main conditions for successfully completing the subject Anatomy 1

Requirements	Details
Lecture Attendance	- Minimum 75% active attendance - Max 3 unexcused absences allowed
Practical Attendance	- 100% mandatory attendance - Max 3 excused absences (for serious health/personal reasons) - Absences must be compensated by end of semester
Compensation of Missed Practicals	- Compensation allowed through other group sessions or self-study - Not allowed during the week before practical test (repetition week)
Tests Required	- 3 theoretical (written) tests - 3 practical tests
Points per Test	- Theoretical tests: 120 points total (40 each) - Practical tests: 60 points total (20 each)
Minimum Pass Marks	- Theoretical: 24 points per test (60%) - Practical: 12 points per test (60%)
Retake - First Attempt	- Theoretical: during next week's practical session - Practical: on Friday of the following week
Retake - Second Attempt	- During the Winter Semester (WS) examination period
Missed Tests (Any Reason)	- No alternative dates - Student must take the test on the next scheduled retake date
Missed Retakes	- No replacement date given
Bonus Points	- +1 point for each test (3 theory + 3 practical) passed in regular term - Max 6 bonus points added to final test results
Failure Conditions	- Unjustified absence from tests - Failure to reach 60% on any test (even after 2 retakes) - Not fulfilling attendance or compensation requirements
Final Evaluation	- Based on continuous assessment and final written + picture tests - Grading: A to E (Pass), Fx (Fail)
