I. Requirements for the Successful Completion of Practical Classes and Seminars

- **Attendance:**
 - **100% mandatory attendance** at practical sessions at the respective clinics according to the schedule.
 - Attendance at seminars is **optional**, but strongly recommended.
 - **Test:**
 - At the end of the block, it is necessary to obtain at least **60%** of the total score on the written test in the **ROGO** system.
 - **Absences:**
 - A maximum of **2 excused absences** is allowed, and each missed practical must be compensated.
 - Planned or unexpected absences must be reported to the respective clinic.
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II. Requirements for Successfully Completing the Course and Earning Credits

- Successfully meet the requirements of practical classes.
 - At the end of the block, complete a **ROGO test consisting of 30 questions**.
 - Complete **2 night shifts** in surgical outpatient clinics according to the schedule.
 - The results of assessment tests are evaluated according to percentage success in accordance with the Study Regulations of UPJŠ, Faculty of Medicine, Part II, Article 13, Paragraph 4.
 - **In case of rotation abroad, a written, stamped and signed confirmation from the teaching institution must be presented. Students are required to be present for the final test in ROGO system – written on the last day of practical classes – on-site at UPJŠ FM.**
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III. Alternative (Distance) Form of Teaching

In the event of a transition to distance learning:

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1. Teachers communicate with students via MS Teams, email, or other online platforms.
2. Teachers may assign written tasks or reports for completion.
3. Practical classes are carried out according to the existing schedule and content.
4. Assigned tasks are evaluated by the respective instructors.
5. Knowledge is verified remotely in the form of a test.
6. Successful completion of the course will be assessed based on:
 - attendance (presence),
 - submitted written assignments,
 - test results.
