I. Requirements for Successful Completion of Practical Sessions and Lectures

1. Attendance:

- **Practical sessions** – mandatory (100% attendance required).
- **Lectures** – optional, but strongly recommended.

2. Assessment During the Semester:

- Students must obtain at least **60% of the total points** from the credit test.

3. Absences:

- A maximum of **2 excused absences** is allowed, and each missed practical must be compensated.
- Planned or unforeseen absences must be reported to the teacher **by email, between 7:00 and 17:00** on the day of the practical session.

4. Documentation:

- A confirmation of completing the replacement practical session **recorded in the student logbook** is required.

II. Requirements for Successful Completion of the Course and Awarding of Credits

1. Basic Requirements:

- Successful completion of practical sessions.

2. Assessment:

- Credit tests are evaluated according to the percentage of points achieved, in accordance with the **Study Regulations of UPJŠ in Košice, Faculty of Medicine (Part II, Article 13, Section 4)**.

3. Final Examination:

- **Form of examination:** oral.
- Students must bring their **logbook** with confirmed attendance of practical sessions and the **evaluation from the credit test**.
- The final grade reflects both credit test results and performance at the final exam.

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III. Alternative Form of Teaching

In the event of a transition to distance learning:

1. Teachers communicate with students via **MS Teams, email, or other online platforms.**
2. Teachers may assign written tasks or reports for completion.
3. Practical sessions follow the existing schedule and content structure.
4. Assigned tasks are evaluated by the respective instructors.
5. Knowledge is assessed remotely in the form of a test.
6. Successful completion of the course will be based on:
 - o attendance (presence),
 - o submitted written assignments,
 - o test results.
