The Study Program Board (SPB) is a permanent body of the UPJŠ in Košice, which is governed by the [Rector's Decision No. 2/2025](#), which issues the Rules of the Internal System for Ensuring and Verifying the Quality of Education, Scientific, Research, Development, Artistic or Other Creative and Support Activities at the Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice (Part III. Art. 14). The SPC was established for the purpose of ensuring and monitoring the quality of the study program and its activities are governed by the [Rector's Decision No. 4/2025](#), which issues the Rules of the SPB's Activities at the UPJŠ in Košice. The SPB is chaired by the person responsible for the study program (PRSP). The SPB in the SP *Clinical Biochemistry*, within the framework of its activities and in cooperation with the [Board for Internal Quality Verification UPJŠ](#), prepares, for example:

- proposes amendments to the existing study program and implements monitoring of the study program in order to ensure the required level of quality of graduates,
- ensures fulfilment of the requirements for ensuring the quality of educational activities resulting from legal regulations and internal regulations of UPJŠ,
- receives suggestions related to the implementation of the study program from the internal and external environment from all interested parties, evaluates them, and takes measures to eliminate the identified shortcomings,
- at least once a year, processes a report on the internal assessment of the quality of educational activities within the study program and takes measures to improve quality.

The SPB, in cooperation with the Study program commission (CPC), proposes dissertation supervisors, adjustments to subject information sheets, including updates of the teacher and recommended literature, and inclusion of new elective subjects. The Study Program Council analyses, evaluates, and publishes quantitative and qualitative indicators for the study program, as determined by the [Internal Quality Assurance and Verification System](#) at UPJŠ in Košice.
