

Dear students,

The exam from Psychology and Medical Communication is performed in the form of ROGO test (<https://rogo.lf.upjs.sk/>). Registration will be possible in AIS from 1st of May.

Students do participate in exam after meeting all duties and conditions. If student enters the test despite missing duties and conditions, test result will not be accepted. Students are recommended to check out their familiarity with the system, skills in testing ROGO, and auditorium (updated in AIS) before entering the exam.

The test consists of 30 questions extracted from the lectures from Psychology & Medical Communication; with an access to lectures at Portal UPJS and here:

Each test question comprises four statements, but only one is accurate. The test lasts 20 minutes. After 20 minutes, the exam must be completed manually; students are not logged out via the ROGO system. After surpassing the time restriction, the teacher will be notified that the student did not maintain time. It refers to reassessing test results or declining to accept the examination. Students who do not pass the final test (< 60%) have the opportunity to perform the retake exam. The %-results are transferred into the mark in a following range:

91 to 100% awarded 'Pass - A - Excellent',

84 to 90 % awarded 'Pass - B - Very Good',

75 to 83 % awarded 'Pass - C - Good',

68 to 74 % awarded 'Pass - D - Satisfactory',

60 to 67 % awarded 'Pass - E - Sufficient',

<60% failed - FX - insufficient.
