

Assessment of the student's learning achievements in Genetics and Regenerative Medicine in Dentistry

Assessment of the student's learning achievements is carried out as a combination of:

- continuous monitoring of the study during the teaching period of the semester (40%)
- and the oral examination during the examination period of the semester (60%).

1. Continuous monitoring of the study during the teaching part of the summer semester will be realized in the form of **two written** tests.

Mandatory 100% participation in practical exercises is the part of the assessment.

- The course textbook (printed or electronic) is required during practical lessons and must be used for laboratory reports and task assignments. Mobile phones are prohibited unless authorized by the teacher.
- Non-participation in practical exercises must be properly excused with the teacher, who will determine a substitution/compensation in the corresponding form.
- A student can have **a maximum of three excused exercises** during the semester.

2. Conditions for subject completion:

- Successful completion of the practical exercises (see paragraph 1).
- Attendance at 10 out of 14 lectures.
- Obtaining **at least 50% from each test** (necessary to register for the oral exam).
- Successful completion of the oral exam.
- A student who cannot take part in the writing of the tests in regular term but properly excuses his/her absence (medical certificate from a doctor **no later than 3 calendar days from the date of writing the tests**) has one alternative date set for all excused tests during the last week of the teaching period of the semester. This term is counted as a regular term.
- A student who fails to properly excuse his absence from the test will be given 0 %.
- A student **who fails to obtain 50% from each test** in the regular term can **once retake** the corresponding test in the last week of the teaching period of the winter semester during the lecture. An alternative term for properly apologized students who could not attend the retake will be announced later, if necessary.

Procedure for the final evaluation of the study results

Continuous assessment during the summer semester: 0 – 40 points

Oral examination: A – 60 points B – 52 points C – 44 points
D – 36 points E – 28 points Fx – 0 points
