

CONDITIONS FOR COMPLETING THE FINAL EXAM FROM SUBJECT **EPIDEMIOLOGY**  
FOR **GENERAL MEDICINE**, 4<sup>th</sup> year.

---

Only students meeting the conditions for the subject Epidemiology will be allowed to register for the final exam (written online test using ROGO system).

**Students** are obliged to **register for the exam using AIS system** and have internet access in the chosen date and time.

**The exam** is in the form of a **written test**, each having **50 questions**. Each question has 4 different answers and only one is correct. The total time for completing the test is 25 minutes. After the time has elapsed, it will no longer be possible to send the test and the student will be assessed with the classification grade Fx (fail).

For the **successful completion of the exam**, a **minimum of 60%** of correct answers is needed.

**Assessment scale:**

A (excellent): 93 – 100% (47 – 50 points)

B (very good): 85 – 92% (43 – 46 points)

C (good): 77 – 84% (39 – 42 points)

D (satisfactory): 69 – 76% (35 – 38 points)

E (sufficient): 60 – 68% (30 – 34 points)

Fx (fail): 59% and less (29 points and less)
