Adjustment of Calendar of the summer semester of the academic year 2019/2020

In accordance with Rector's Ordinance No. 4/2020, ordered by Rector of UPJŠ in Košice Prof. RNDr. Pavol Sovák, CSc., on the course and completion of the teaching process during the summer semester of the academic year 2019/2020 at the Pavol Jozef Šafárik University on 25th March 2020, I hereby impose following measures for the implementation of the Calendar of the summer semester of the 2019/2020 academic year.

Article 1 Final Degree Theses

- The deadline for submission of electronic version of Degree Theses through the Academic information system for students of Bachelor and Magister study programmes shall be on 30th April 2020.
- The deadline for submission of a printed and bound copy of the Degree Thesis for students of Bachelor and Magister study programmes is the day of the defence of the Degree Thesis. The student shall submit together with Degree Thesis in hardcover, two signed License agreements and an Analytical Sheet.
- 3. If there are obstacles to the elaboration of a Bachelor or Diploma Thesis on time due to restrictions imposed by the Government in relation to COVID-19, the student may change the topic of the Degree Thesis after the supervisor's agreement without request form, to have a possibility for the elaboration of Degree Thesis using already available data and materials. The supervisor of the Degree Thesis will change in the Academic information system the Degree Thesis title and the purpose of the Degree Thesis, both in Slovak and in English language.
- 4. The deadline for submission of the Degree Thesis for students of Doctoral study programmes remains unchanged.

Article 2 State examinations

- 1. Students of Bachelor, Magister and Doctoral degree programs in current academic year register for the state examination only electronically through the study referee, one week before the term of the state exam at the latest.
- 2. Students may apply to unsubscribe from the date of the state examination through their study referee.
- Student shall carry out the practical part of the state examination according to the course guarantor's instructions and student shall participate in the defence of the Degree Thesis on the day of the theoretical part of the state examination.
- 4. The dates for the state examinations are as follows:

a/ Bachelor and Magister degree programmes

b/ General Medicine program

18.5.2020 - 22.5.2020	without change
8.6.2020 - 12.6.2020	substitute date for cancelled date of the state examination in
	Internal Medicine and in Surgery.

c/ **Dental Medicine program**

18.5.2020 - 22.5.2020	without change

22.6.2020 - 26.6.2020	substitute and retake date.

- 5. The term of the state examination in August 2020 remains unchanged, i.e. from 17.8.2020 to 21.8.2020 for Bachelor, Magister and Doctoral degree programmes.
- 6. If there are obstacles to taking state examinations at the Faculty due to restrictions imposed by the government in relation to COVID-19, students will be notified electronically of the form of the state examination.
- 7. The Graduation ceremony of the 2019/2020 academic year is cancelled due to COVID-19. In case that reasons related to the restrictions imposed by the Government cease to exist, the term of Graduation ceremony will be published on the Faculty website.

Article 3 Entrance Examination

- 1. The talent examination for applicants of the Bachelor degree study program in Physiotherapy is cancelled. Applicants will be invited only to the written part of the entrance examination.
- 2. Applicants for Magister study programme in Physiotherapy and in Public Health will be admitted to study without an entrance examination this academic year.
- 3. The date for the written entrance examination for Bachelor and Doctoral degree programs in Slovak language is scheduled from 29.06.2020 to 03.07.2020. The alternative date for taking the entrance examination is scheduled for 07.07.2020.
- 4. The date for the entrance examination for the study programmes in English language is scheduled for 08.07.2020.
- 5. If there are obstacles to the entrance examination at the Faculty of Medicine due to restrictions imposed by the Government in relation to COVID-19, the applicant will be notified electronically of the form of the entrance examination.

Article 4 The completion of the examination period

- 1. All exams will be carried out by distance according to the teacher's instructions.
- 2. If the reasons for the restrictions imposed by the Government in regards with COVID-19 are no longer present, all exams will be carried out on a full-time basis. Students will be informed by an announcement published on the Faculty website.

Article 5 Final Provisions

This Provision enter into force and effect on the date of its approval by the Academic Senate UPJŠ in Košice, by voting per rollam and the signature of Dean of Faculty.
