

Conditions for passing subject ANATOMY 2 for Dental Medicine

Exam consists of:

1/ Practical part – anatomical pictures: consists of 30 structures = 30 points.

To continue to the next part of the exam, student has to achieve 20 points at least. Points obtained from this part of the exam, are not added to the final evaluation!

2/ Theoretical part – written test: consists of 100 questions (each question has 4 choices, but only one of them is correct).

3/ Evaluation score:

A = 100 - 93 points

B = 92 - 85 points

C = 84 - 77 points

D = 76 - 69 points

E = 68 - 60 points

Fx = 59 points and less
