Date	Lectures – (Tuesday)	Practicals
1. week 15.2.-19.2.	Thorax – borders. Thoracic wall. Diaphragm. <i>doc. Hodorová</i>	Skeleton of thorax, joints, muscles, vessels and nerves of thoracic wall. Diaphragm. Mammary gland.
2. week 22.2.-25.2.	Mediastinum- division. Superior and inferior mediastinum. Heart – external description. <i>doc. Hodorová</i>	Structures in mediastinum. Heart – outer surface and pericardium.
3. week 1.3.-5.3.	Heart - chambers, valves, cardiac skeleton, conducting system, blood supply. Auscultation of the valves. <i>doc. Hodorová</i>	Heart – chambers, valves, cardiac skeleton, blood supply, points of auscultation. Respiratory system – nasal cavity, nasopharynx.
4. week 8.3.-12.3.	Respiratory system. Upper and lower respiratory tract, lungs, pleura. <i>doc. Hodorová</i>	Larynx, trachea, bronchi, lungs, pleura. Repetition of anatomical structures of thorax.
5. week 15.3.-19.3.	<b>3. written test</b> <i>doc. Hodorová</i> Introduction to digestive system. doc. Mihalik	<b>3rd practical test</b>
6. week 22.3.-26.3.	Digestive system <i>doc. Mihalik</i>	Oral cavity, pharynx, esophagus, stomach, small and large intestine. Liver, pancreas, spleen.
7. week 29.3.-2.4.	Abdominal wall. Inguinal canal. Peritoneum. <i>doc. Hodorová</i>	Lumbar vertebrae, sacrum. Abdominal wall – muscles, vessels and nerves. Inguinal canal. Peritoneum, intraperitoneal organs.
8. week 5.4.-9.4.	Easter	Retroperitoneal structures. Abdominal aorta.
9. week 12.4.-16.4.	Retroperitoneal space. <i>prof. Rybárová</i>	Urinary system. Adrenal glands. Retroperitoneal structures.
10. week 19.4.-23.4.	Urinary system. Adrenal (suprarenal) glands. <i>prof. Rybárová</i>	Retroperitoneal structures.
11. week 26.4.-30.4.	<b>4. A written test</b> Female genital organs. <i>doc. Mihalik</i>	Female genital organs. Internal iliac artery.
12. week 3.5.-7.5.	Autonomic nerv. system. <i>prof. Rybárová</i> Male genital organs. <i>doc. Mihalik</i>	Male genital organs. Rectum.
13. week 10.5.-14.5.	Pelvic floor. Regional anatomy of lesser pelvis. Blood supply, lymphatic drainage and innervation of pelvic organs. <i>prof. Rybárová</i>	Pelvic floor. Repetition of pelvic and abdominal anatomical structures.
14. week 17.5.-21.5.	<b>4. B written test</b> <i>doc. Hodorová</i> Abdomen and pelvis from clinical point of view.	<b>4th practical test</b>
